Laboratory Safety Training for Non-OSU workers

Non-OSU workers, including volunteers, temporary agency workers, visiting scientists, etc. are required to complete lab safety training if they work in OSU labs or are part of an OSU research project.

Access to training materials and documentation of training involves a different process than the one followed by OSU employees.

Non-OSU workers who require lab safety training, but do not have access to the materials used by OSU employees will need to use the trainings developed by Environmental Health and Safety:

The PI and employee/volunteer MUST document completion of the training. Use the Training Documentation Sheet to record the training, and keep the completed form in the PI's Lab Safety Binder or the departmental office. It is not required that documentation of training for non-OSU workers be provided to EH&S.
