Asbestos Overview

Training and Medical Surveillance

- Employees who work (conduct surveys, sampling, or abatement activities) with asbestos as part of their work should receive an asbestos physical, including medical clearance to use a respirator. Any employee who may be working on asbestos abatement should contact EH&S to enroll in the program.
- <u>Asbestos Awareness Training</u> should be provided for facilities maintenance employees who **work around asbestos**.

State Regulations

 Oregon-OSHA and DEQ regulations on asbestos require that building materials be sampled prior to demolition, replacement, or remodeling.

OSU Policy

- OSU construction safety policy requires sampling for any construction/remodeling that will impact any of the following building materials, surfaces, or equipment below:
 - o Carpet
 - o Floor Tiles
 - o Walls
 - o Ceilings
 - o Roofs
 - o Sprayed-On-Insulation
 - o Insulation on Plumbing
 - o Laboratory Benches, Cabinets, and Other Laboratory Furnishings
 - o Fume Hoods
 - o Chalkboards

Sampling and Surveys

- The campus survey list may not cover ALL regulated material.
- When requested, Facilities Services (for maintenance related projects) or EH&S (for capital projects) will perform or arrange the necessary sampling prior to any demolition activities.
- Sample analysis **fees** may be the responsibility of the requesting Department/Unit.
- EH&S will consult with departments after the sample results are evaluated.
- Regulatory fines issued by OR-OSHA or DEQ for improper demolition or disposal will be the responsibility of the department or unit.
